Assignments is divided into five components. Class Progress allows you to view class and student progress. Assignment Status allows you to view status by assignment or by student with options to unassign assignments and students. In Assignment Builder you can build, edit, save, and delete assignments and assign them to your classes and students. Assignment Archive contains all your assignments in addition to assignments for your school and for all schools. Submitted Projects launches the Grader interface for Odyssey Writer. The in-tray icon on the button notifies you when student projects are ready for evaluation.

For a brief overview of the assignment components, move your mouse over each of the component buttons below. Click the button to go to one of the components, or choose the component from the Assignments menu in the navigation bar at the top of the screen.


